Lines spread out like a fan. It has "feet".

Bivalves

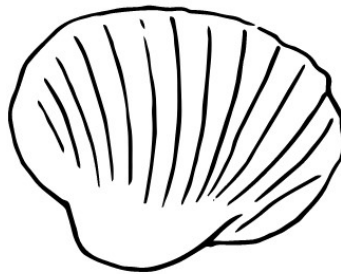


Shaped like a bumpy spoon. Lines are like ripples in a pond.

Bivalves are mollusks that live on the sea floor. They have a soft body inside two shells that are hinged on one side.



Shaped like a rounded triangle. Lines go from side to side.



Shaped like a scallop but lines are in even rows like corn rows.



Shaped like an oyster, but smaller, darker and smoother.
